Program Outline

- 1) Kamloops Minor Baseball Association (KMBA) will offer a minimum of one with the maximum number of scholarships being dependent on the number of applicants and endowment funds available for distribution that year.
- 2) Scholarships shall be awarded by KMBA to any successful applicant who is currently, and for two or more years, has played within KMBA.
- 3) The qualifications of recipients have to be:
 - a. Proceeding from Grade 12 to any accredited university, college or other secondary institution approved by the Scholarship Committee. Must be a Canadian Institution (US schools will not qualify).
 - b. Attending a post-secondary institute, but who are under 19 years of age as of January 1st of the current playing season
 - c. Must have a minimum "B" average
 - d. Must have demonstrated good citizenship, personality and leadership in a non- playing capacity for their association.
 - e. Even though not mandatory, preference will be given to those players who plan on continuing playing baseball at the post-secondary level.
- 4) All applicants must follow the scholarship application process outlined in this policy in order to be considered for a KMBA Scholarship. KMBA reserves the right to forego processing any applications from applicants who do not follow the procedure outlined below.
- 5) The funds will be withheld until the appropriate information is provided to the BC Interior Foundation as outlined in the scholarship application checklist included with this package.
- 6) A scholarship that is awarded, but not availed within two (2) years of the award winner's high school graduation year will be deemed to be null and void. The aforementioned scholarship award will be then awarded to a new candidate the following year.

<u>Application Process</u>

- 1) All Scholarship applications must be submitted no later than August 10th of each year.
- 2) All applications must contain two components:
 - a. Submit a completed application form
 - b. A transcript of the student's marks or other record of the applicant's grades

Scholarship/Bursary Distributions will be sent directly to your Post-Secondary Institution & cannot be awarded to individuals. Distribution processing time may take 2-4 weeks for BCICF to process; your University/College may also need additional processing time so please plan accordingly. "
