Progra m Outline

- 1) Kamloops Minor Baseball Association (KMBA) will offer one or more scholarships annually depending on the number of qualified applicants and endowment funds available for distribution that year.
- 2) Scholarships shall be awarded by KMBA to any successful applicant who is currently, and for two or more years, has played within KMBA within 18U or Challenger division.
- 3) The qualifications of recipients have to include:
 - A. Proceeding from Grade 12 to any accredited university, college or other secondary institution approved by the Scholarship Committee. **If a US Institution only those that are listed as a qualified donee by the CRA will be eligible (list can be found at <https://www.canada.ca/en/revenue-agency/services/charities-giving/other-organizations-that-issue-donation-receipts-qualified-donees/other-qualified-donees-listings/list-prescribed-universities-outside-canada.html>)**
 - B. Preference will be given to students with a minimum “B” average and/or a student who demonstrated exceptional citizenship, attitude and leadership off the field of play for the association.
- 4) All applicants must follow the scholarship application process outlined in this policy in order to be considered for a KMBA Scholarship. KMBA reserves the right to forego processing any applications from applicants who do not follow the procedure outlined below.
- 5) The funds will be withheld until the appropriate information is provided to the BC Interior Foundation as outlined in the scholarship application checklist included with this package.
- 6) Any scholarship that is awarded must successfully complete step 5 above within 18 months of the award winner’s high school graduation month or the scholarship will be deemed to be null and void. (ie if grad June 2025 must enrol by December 31, 2026)

Application Process

- 1) All Scholarship applications must be submitted no later than June 1st of each year.
- 2) All applications must contain two components:
 - a. Submit a completed application form
 - b. A transcript of the student’s marks or other record of the applicant’s grades
